

Contractors

Health & Safety

The site safely handles large quantities of various hazardous chemicals and complies with all the necessary legislation and codes of practice.

All visitors must be accompanied or supervised by a member of Holchem staff at all times.

Access to the technical laboratory, process and warehousing is restricted.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) will be issued where required.

Vehicles & Pedestrians
